
Thanks for allowing me to be the driver of the day and letting me tell my quick story of one of my adventures in the past 30 days!

THE EXTREME 4x4 AUSTRIAN ROADTRIP

CAR: FORD BRONCO, 2021

LOCATIONS: LECH, SÖLDEN, INNSBRUCK & KAPRUN

TIME: 7 DAYS

After a year of preparations Darin, Kyle, Leah and Michelle of team Direwheel have teamed up to overcome the extreme 4x4 Austrian roadtrip.

"It wasn't an easy task but now that i look back at it, it sure was one of the best experience of my life.", says Michelle after returning from the challenge. The roadtrip put the 4 members on a difficult path to travel to 4 Austrian cities using the most dangerous roads in the most hazardous conditions.

The 4 took turns driving the 2021 Ford Bronco around the Austrian alps most treacherous roads. "Every day felt like a new day full of challenges, we never knew what to expect next. Sure we knew what we've gotten ourselves into but nothing prepares you for unexpected situations.", says team leader Darin.

The first days took the team from Lech to Sölden. Not through the conventional roads, but through the mountains. The team packed up a bunch of supplies including plenty of water and food, but also proper equipment and clothing for if things could go south. They never knew what to expect, especially during

the stormy winter. The first part of the journey was pleasant. As the team left Lech to head up the mountains they were making quick work of the challenge. "It helped that the Ford Bronco was fairly new and was specifically made to take on such rough terrain", noted Leah.

However when they passed the first check-in station things started to get a little tense. During the decent on one of the mountains the car had to stop for a snowy surprise. The entire road ahead of them down the mountain was blocked by a wall of snow. The team had to get out of the car to start making room so they could get past.

"Nobody comes up to take these roads during winter which is what makes these roads so dangerous", says Kyle. "I hate to admit it but clearing the road took us a lot longer than we had expected, there was just so much snow it wasn't safe for us to just drive through it."



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
